

School of Sport Education NT Exemption Policy.

Introduction

The School of Sport Education NT organises programs, Championships and Development and Interstate Selection Camps, which provide an opportunity for the selection of interstate teams. The School of Sport Education NT policy requires students to attend the relevant program to be eligible for interstate selection.

The School of Sport Education NT receives requests to allow students to be considered for interstate team selection even though they may be unable to follow selection processes requiring attendance at the relevant School of Sport Education NT Championship or Development and Interstate Camp.

Purpose

To set out the process by which a student may request exemption from attending a selection event due to extenuating circumstances.

Policy

It is acknowledged that there will be circumstances when requests for exemption is warranted and consideration is required on a case by case basis. There is no guarantee of selection if exemption is granted.

Consideration will only be possible if the exemption process has been adhered to. Selection for interstate teams without attendance at the relevant Championship or Development and Interstate Camp can only be considered if a student has applied for and been granted exemption.

The exemption application and approval process is set out in Attachment A.

Definitions

Exemption - an allowance that is made for a student to be a member of an interstate team although they have not met all of the selection policy requirements.

Exemption Process - the process for assessing applications for exemption.
